

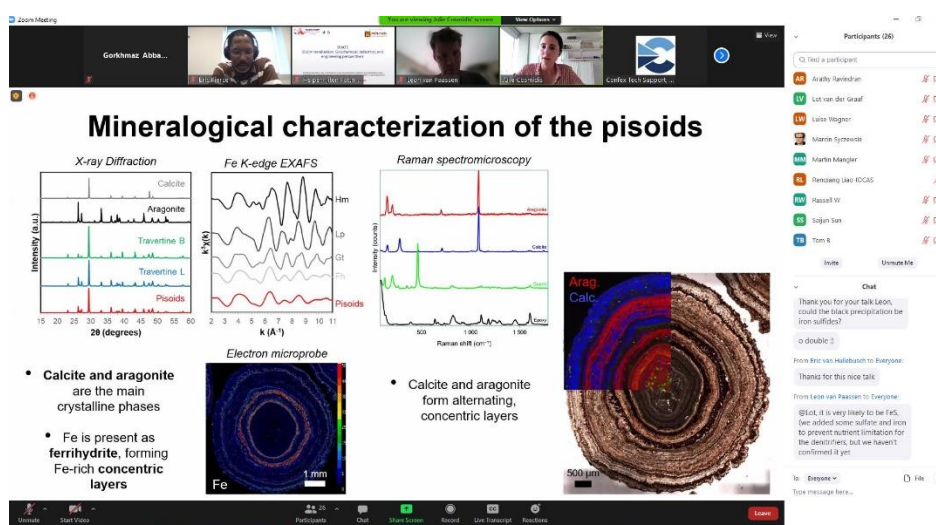
Report of the Goldschmidt2021 conference for Talent Support Council of ELTE University
